CURFEW FOR MINORS

18.02 Responsibility of Parents and Guardians

18.03 Penalty

18.01 HOURS. A minor under the age of 18 years shall not be present either on foot or in a vehicle upon the streets, alleys, sidewalks, parks, playgrounds, public grounds or other unsupervised places in the Village between the hours of 11:00pm and 5:00am. This Chapter does not apply to a minor accompanied by his parent, guardian or other adult person having legal custody or control of the minor, or where the minor is upon an emergency errand directed by his parent, guardian, or other adult person having legal custody or control of the minor, or where the minor is pursuing the duties of his employment, or going directly between employment and home, or if the minor is returning directly home from attending an organized school activity, including but not limited to dances, or if the minor was exercising First Amendment rights protected by the United States Constitution, such as the free exercise of religion, freedom of speech or the right to assembly, or if the minor was attending a faith-based group or an official community-based group.

18.02 RESPONSIBILITY OF PARENTS AND GUARDIANS. A parent, guardian or other adult person having legal custody or control of any person under the age of 18 years shall not allow or permit such minor to violate this Chapter.

18.03 PENALTY. The penalty for violation of the provisions of this section, unless otherwise specifically provided, shall be a penalty as provided in Section 19.04 of this Code. (Ord. 2014-01 on 9-18-14)
