ORDINANCES...

STREET PARKING PROHIBITED BETWEEN 2 AM - 6 AM

Vehicles may not be parked on village streets between 2 AM - 6 AM. If you need to leave a car on the street overnight, please notify the Wind Point Police Department at (262) 639-3022 with the license plate number.

PUBLIC WORKS...

ASH BORER TREATMENT

Ash trees located on village land are treated every two years, with the next treatment due in fall 2020. If your trees are due this year, please arrange treatment with a landscape service. In late spring of 2020, residents will be given a chance to sign up for the 2020 fall coordinated treatment plan. Also, according to Affordable Tree Care, if an Ash tree has not previously been treated, it will not survive.

CURB & GUTTER MAINTENANCE

If plant growth is occurring in the cracks of the curb of your home and/or seams that join your driveway to the road, please remove the growth as soon as possible, no later than the first frost. For those who have a lawn care service, please notify your service to complete this task. Pavement lifespan is reduced by plant growth -- your cooperation will help minimize repair costs and extend curb lifespan.

UNCONTROLLED INTERSECTIONS

Multiple near collisions at village intersections have been reported. Please use caution and follow the rules published in the Wisconsin Motorist's Handbook. To view the handbook, visit: <https://wisconsindot.gov/Documents/dmv/shared/bds126-motorists-handbook.pdf>



At an intersection where there are no signs or traffic lights, you must yield to vehicles coming from the right. At a four-way stop, the driver reaching the intersection first goes first (after coming to a complete stop.) If more than one vehicle arrives at the same time, the vehicle on the right goes first. You must yield to vehicles already on the main road if you are entering a road from a driveway, alley or roadside.

GARBAGE, RECYCLING & BULK PICK UP

Recycling pays off! In May 2019, North Bay earned a \$1,661.81 grant for recyclables collected the prior year. North Bay's single stream recycling (all recyclables are mixed together) simplifies recycling which maximizes our grant. Keep up the great work!

Electronics: Johns Disposal is a Wisconsin registered collector of electronics (desktop and laptop computers, printers, scanners, fax machines, copiers, video display devices, monitors, televisions, keyboards, mice, hard drives, flash drives, external modems and other computer devices, DVD/VCR/DVR/Video players). **At the owner's expense, residents may schedule a pick-up by calling Johns Disposal at: (262) 473-4700.**

LEAF PICK-UP

Weekly Monday curbside leaf pick up begins Monday, October 14th, and ends on the first snowfall. Please do not mix other yard waste with leaves. To allow proper rainwater flow, please maintain 6 inch gap between the curb and leaf pile.

YARD WASTE

Pick up of other yard waste (grass, plants, small branches) will continue through November. Place yard waste at your curb by 7 AM using the following methods:

- Bagged in a 30-gallon paper bag
- Bundled - all branches smaller than 6" in diameter and up to 4 feet long tied with twine
- Affix one Yard Waste sticker on each bag or bundle
- Yard Waste stickers are \$1 each and may be purchased from all six North Bay Trustees

CHIEF INSPECTOR & POLL WORKERS NEEDED!

The Village is currently seeking at least one additional Chief Inspector and additional poll workers for the upcoming year.

- Any qualified elector of North Bay may serve as an Election Official
- Election Officials are paid (Poll Worker \$7.25/hour, Chief Inspector \$9.25/hour)
- You do not have work every election
- Election Day is divided into 3 shifts (you do not have to work every shift)
Shift 1: 7 AM - 11:30 AM Shift 2: 11:30 AM - 4 PM Shift 3: 4 PM - 8 PM
- Each shift requires 1 Chief Inspector and 2 Poll Workers
- Chief Inspectors are required to attend a one-hour mandatory training session prior to each election
- Every election official shall be able to read and write English
- An election official may not be a candidate in that election
