2019 PROPERTY TAX PAYMENTS

Property tax bills were mailed to North Bay property owners on December 2, 2019. Copies of tax bills are available online using Racine County's [MyTaxBill web app](#). Payment options are located on the tax bill insert.

Once receipted by the County, tax payments are posted on the Racine County system. Posting of tax payments made at Johnson Bank may be delayed. Tax bills or payment questions? Contact the Village Treasurer at 262-681-0898 or vnbtreasurer@northbay-wi.us.

LOTTERY & GAMING CREDIT

If your North Bay home was your primary residence as of January 1, 2019, look at your tax bill to verify the credit was applied or check the [Lottery Credit Finder](#). The 2019 Lottery & Gaming Credit set by the State is \$187.02 and is based on revenue from the Wisconsin lottery, pari-mutuel on-track betting and bingo during the year. The credit can only be claimed for one property and cannot be claimed by renters or on business property, rental units, vacant land, garages or other property that is not the primary residence of the owner. To add or remove the credit from the 2019 tax bill, contact the Village Treasurer at vnbtreasurer@northbay-wi.us or 262-681-0898 no later than January 31st, 2020.

2019 WISCONSIN INCOME TAX FILING

When completing your individual Wisconsin Income Tax returns, please indicate the Tax District on page 1 as the Village of NORTH BAY, County of RACINE and School District Number 4620. This information will provide the Village with valuable tax credits.

2020 DOG LICENSE REMINDER

If you own a dog, please complete and return the dog license application inserted with your tax bill by January 31st, 2020. Additional applications are available on the [Village website](#). State law requires dogs 5 months of age or older to be licensed each year. Owners of unregistered dogs may be cited by the Wind Point Police Department for non-compliance with local and state statutes.

FIRE HYDRANTS

If a fire hydrant is located on or adjacent to your property, please keep a **snow-free circular zone around** your hydrant of **3 feet** to ensure fire department access.

SNOW/SALTING

Village streets are plowed when there is 2-3 inches of snow, or at the discretion of the Public Works Trustee. Street intersections will be salted as needed. Since Cross Creek Road, Lansdale Lane, South Creek Road, and North Street are more difficult to clear, salt barrels are provided at the entrances for resident usage in those specific areas.
