2020 ELECTIONS

VILLAGE BOARD ELECTION

Three village offices are up for election this spring. Each position serves two years.

- ★ **Trustee #1 Public Works | Incumbent Paul Schroeder**
- ★ **Trustee #2 Water & Waste Water | Incumbent Rick Cermak**
- ★ **Treasurer | Incumbent Robert O'Brien**

Duties of each position appear in [Chapter 2](#) of the Village Code of Ordinances. If you are interested in running, please review [Chapter 3](#) and plan to attend the Village Caucus.

Every candidate for any elective Village office shall be nominated by caucus or by nomination of papers in accordance with the provisions of Section 8.05 of the Wisconsin Statutes. Residents are encouraged to attend the Village Caucus and all Board Meetings.

VILLAGE CAUCUS - NOMINATION DAY!

Monday, January 13, 2020 | 7:00 PM

To appear on the Ballot for the Village of North Bay Executive Board, new candidates must be nominated by 2 eligible voting residents at the Village Caucus on Monday, January 13th, 2020, which is also the first 2020 Executive Board Meeting. Candidates are encouraged to attend the Caucus, however, if they are unable to attend, they may still be nominated and file the required Candidacy papers with the Village Clerk within 5 days of the nomination. VOTER REGISTRATION

Online voter registration is available now through January 28th, 2020 to eligible Wisconsin Voters who have a current and valid Wisconsin Driver License or Wisconsin State ID Card! Your name, date of birth, Wisconsin Driver License or State ID number, and address must all match the information on file with the Wisconsin DMV. Pre-registered voters must present a valid photo ID on election day. If you miss the January 28th deadline, or prefer to register by mail or in person, please contact [Clerk Panthofer](#).

The 2020-2022 Chief Inspectors were named at the November 25th Village of North Bay Board Meeting. Returning Chief Inspectors include **Connie & Paul Eberly** and **Mark Schall**. New Chief Inspectors include **Richard Schmitt** and **Jo Gravitter**.

Poll Worker Election Day Facts...

- High School students ages 16 and 17 may become a Poll Worker at the same polling site where a parent votes. Parental consent and school principal permission required in advance.
- Election Day is divided into 3 shifts (poll workers do not have to work every shift)
Shift 1: 7 AM - 11:30 AM, Shift 2: 11:30 AM - 4 PM, Shift 3: 4 PM - 8 PM
- Each shift requires 1 Chief Inspector and 2 Poll Workers. Chief Inspectors overlap 30 minutes to ensure a seamless transition.
- Any qualified elector of North Bay may serve as an Election Official
- Election Officials are paid (Poll Worker \$7.25/hour, Chief Inspector \$9.25/hour).
- Poll workers do not have to work every election
- New and returning poll workers are highly encouraged to attend a training session before working each election
- Chief Inspectors are required to complete a minimum of 6 hours training every 2 years
- An election official may not be a candidate in that election
