The Wind Point-North Bay Joint Municipal Court judge's seat is currently open due to the death of Judge John Knuteson. The Village Boards of Wind Point and North Bay are seeking candidates to temporarily fill the office of Municipal Judge. The appointed individual will serve until April 30, 2021. A special election will be held concurrently with the 2021 Spring Election to fill the remainder of the term which will begin on May 1, 2021 and end on April 30, 2023.



The Village Boards of Wind Point and North Bay will conduct a formal interview of the interested candidates at Joint Meeting on June 11. The appointment procedure will be as follows:

- The appointment process will be held in Open Session.
- Candidates will be interviewed by the Village Boards of North Bay and Wind Point
- Each individual who submitted an application will be provided up to 5-minutes to give a verbal presentation to the Board's (presentation is optional). Presentation order will be determined by a random drawing of names at the meeting.
- The Village Board members will take turns asking a question of the interested persons.
- The Joint Village Board will then vote upon the appointment in Open Session.
