## 2020 Annual Garlic Mustard Pull



1<sup>st</sup> year plant. Low scalloped leaf

Increasingly garlic mustard can be found in lawns. Proper removal is the homeowner's responsibility

Call if you need help identifying it, and we will demonstrate the best pulling method

**Please DO NOT dispose of garlic mustard in your compost pile!**

Collect in bags and dispose with your trash

**Garlic mustard** grows aggressively, far outpacing native species.

Left untreated, it will spread and choke out our precious native plants.



2<sup>nd</sup> year plant. Stalk with white flowers
