VILLAGE HALL REOPENS, COVID PRECAUTIONS IN EFFECT

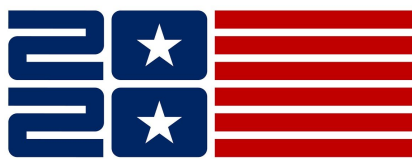

PROPERTY TAX INSTALLMENT DUE JULY 31st | The second Installment of the property tax bill is due by July 31, 2020. Payment can be made in one of two ways: 1) Mail or drop off a check payable to: Racine County Treasurer, 730 Wisconsin Avenue, Racine, WI 53403 or 2) drop off your payment at Johnson Bank (4001 North Main Street).
