COVID PRECAUTIONS CONTINUE



MASKS REQUIRED IN PUBLIC BUILDINGS | All persons entering Village Hall are required to wear a mask. At this time, the maximum occupancy of Village Hall is 12 persons. ABSENTEE BALLOTS | To date, 90 absentee ballots have been mailed and more than half of those have been returned to Village Hall. Absentee Ballots must be returned to Village Hall no later than 8 PM on Election Day to be counted.

Absentee Voters who opt to vote in person on Election Day are asked to bring the entire absentee ballot mailing and valid photo ID to Village Hall on Election Day. If you forget to bring your absentee mailing, or if the US Postal Service did not deliver your absentee ballot by Election Day, you may still vote. The original absentee ballot will be spoiled. The Officials will issue a new ballot. The Chief & Clerk will document that you voted in person instead of Absentee to comply with strict WEC rules.

GENERAL ELECTION DEADLINES

October 30th - 5 PM	Deadline for North Bay residents to register in person at North Bay Village Hall. In person registration is by appointment only.
	Deadline to request an Absentee Ballot - Indefinitely Confined
November 3rd - 5 PM	Deadline for Hospitalized Voters to request an absentee ballot be brought to them by an appointed agent if they are hospitalized in the 7 days preceding the election. Hospitalized electors may request an absentee ballot between October 27th, 2020 and November 3rd at 5 PM.
	Deadline to request an Absentee Ballot - Military
November 3rd - 8 PM	Deadline to return an Absentee Ballot. If you already received an absentee ballot, North Bay electors must return your ballot by mail or delivery to Village Hall by 8:00 PM.
