3 VILLAGE OFFICES UP FOR ELECTION | If you are interested in running for one of 3 Board of Trustees positions on April 7th, 2021, please review [Chapter 3](#) and plan to attend the Village Caucus. Duties of each position appear in [Chapter 2](#) of the Village Code of Ordinances.

The Village offices that are up for election on April 7th, 2021 appear below. Each position serves two years. Incumbents who do not plan to run for reelection are asked to submit a Notice of Non Candidacy no later than December 27th, 2020.

- ★ **President: Incumbent Roger Mellem**
- ★ **Constable: Incumbent Kristin Wright**
- ★ **Clerk: Incumbent Dori A. Panthofer**

Every candidate for any elected Village office shall be nominated by caucus or by nomination of papers in accordance with the provisions of Section 8.05 of the Wisconsin Statutes. Residents are encouraged to attend the Village Caucus and all Board Meetings.

To appear on the Ballot for the Village of North Bay Executive Board, new candidates must be nominated by 2 eligible voting residents at the Village Caucus on Monday, January 11th, 2021, which is also the first 2021 Executive Board Meeting. Candidates are encouraged to attend the Caucus, however, if they are unable to attend, they may still be nominated and file the required Candidacy papers with the Village Clerk within 5 days of the nomination. 1ST AUTOMATED RECYCLING CART PICK UP IS JANUARY 4TH, 2021 | Bi-weekly automated recycling collection begins on January 4th, 2021. Below are a few reminders:

- Delivery of automated recycle carts is scheduled for December 21st - 31st.
- Recycle pick up is by-weekly. The 2021 schedule is published on the [Village calendar](https://northbay-wi.us/calendar/). The URL is <https://northbay-wi.us/calendar/> .
- The Village recycling contract provides usage of one recycle cart per address. If/when an occupant moves, the cart remains with the house.
- The yellow recycle bins or any non-automated recycle containers will no longer be picked up.
- All residents must use a Johns Disposal Recycle Cart.
- A one time special free pickup of old refuse cans will be announced as soon as the date is scheduled.
- In an automated recycling program, special recycling carts are picked up by a mechanical arm on a truck rather than manually lifted.
- **All items must fit inside the recycle cart.**
- Recycling outside of the cart will not be picked up.
- Additional carts may be rented at \$5 per month, paid annually.
