GARLIC MUSTARD ALERT | Garlic Mustard displaces native plants and grows aggressively in the sun or shade. If left unchecked, one plant becomes 10 in a single year which makes it a constant threat. Residents are encouraged to gather a few friends to help preserve North Bay's very own little wildlife sanctuary that is home to many beautiful Wisconsin native wildflowers located in the ravine.



BEST TIME TO REMOVE IS NOW! The ground is wet and makes for easy pulling. Simply use a hand shovel to loosen the soil to remove the **whole taproot**. To prevent spread, bag and dispose of garlic mustard waste in your regular trash and NOT the yard waste bags.

SPRING CLEAN UP REMINDER | *Please do not rake leaves, twigs or any yard waste into the street or gutter.* Rain washes debris into the storm drains which increases the frequency (and cost) to professionally clean the drains and the standing water on the bridges especially when it freezes also creates undo stress which reduces the lifespan. Limiting expenses helps everyone's property tax bill.

- Bagged in a 30-gallon paper bag
- Bundled - all branches smaller than 6" in diameter and up to 4 feet long tied with twine
- Affix one Yard Waste sticker on each bag or bundle
- Yard Waste stickers are 5 for \$5 and may be purchased from all six North Bay Trustees

CURB & GUTTER MAINTENANCE | With spring comes new plant growth. Please, will you help to minimize curb repair costs and extend curb lifespan? Simply remove the growth that occurs in the cracks and seams of your driveway or curb throughout the growing season. For those who have a lawn care service, please notify your service to complete this task.

2022 FALL ASH BORER TREATMENT | In May, residents will be given a chance to sign up for the 2022 fall coordinated treatment plan. If you have removed a previously treated ash tree, please notify the Clerk at yvbclerk@northbay-wi.us. As a reminder, according to Affordable Tree Care, if an Ash tree has not previously been treated, it will not survive.

2022 HAZARDOUS WASTE | Collections are scheduled on the third Saturday of the month from April 16th through October 15th from 8AM-1PM to allow area residents an opportunity to safely dispose of Household hazardous waste. ELECTRONICS DISPOSAL | Johns Disposal is a Wisconsin registered collector of electronics (desktop and laptop computers, printers, scanners, fax machines, copiers, video display devices, monitors, televisions, keyboards, mice, hard drives, flash drives, external modems and other computer devices, DVD/VCR/DVR/Video players). **At the owner's expense, residents may schedule a pick-up by calling Johns Disposal at: (262) 473-4700.**
