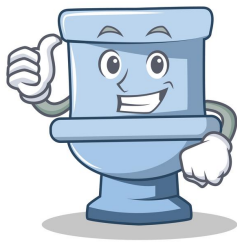
Residents who wish to participate in Trick or Treat should have an outdoor light on.
