4 WAYS TO REGISTER TO VOTE | Proof of residence is required to register to vote. Visit <https://elections.wi.gov/Register> for information about voter eligibility and the 28 day residency requirement.

1. **Online;** up to 20 days before the election. Visit www.myvote.wi.gov/en-us.
2. **By mail;** up to 20 days before the election.
3. **In the Municipal Clerk's Office;** during in person Early Voting
4. **At the Polling Place on Election day.**

ABSENTEE VOTING | On March 14th, 2023, the first wave of Absentee Ballots were mailed to Electors who had a valid Absentee Ballot request on file as of that date. Absentee Ballot requests received after that date are processed in accordance with Wisconsin Election law.

The deadline to register to vote in Absentee is 5 PM Friday, March 31st, 2023. Per the US Postal Service, please allow 7 days for delivery each way. To request an absentee ballot, please visit www.myvote.wi.gov/en-us.

- Place tagged yard waste at your curb by 7 AM
- Bundled - all branches smaller than 6" in diameter and up to 4 feet long tied with twine
- **Affix one full sticker on each bag or bundle.**

2023 DOG LICENSE DUE APRIL 1ST | If you have not already licensed your dog, please complete and return the dog license application by April 1st to avoid a late fee. Applications are available on the [Village website](#). State law requires dogs 5 months of age or older to be licensed each year. Owners of unregistered dogs may be cited by the Wind Point Police Department for non-compliance with local and state statutes.
